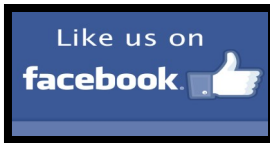

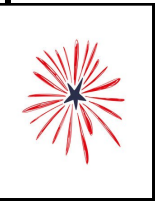
Be sure to report power outages! During non-business hours please call 570-742-8772. If no answer, CALL 911 !!!
